Airport avgas price drops

Bethel committed to being competitive

With the cost of all fuels continuing to drop in recent weeks throughout the US, one price remained the same – Bethel's price for avgas at \$5.35/gallon.

When local pilots and other community members questioned why, we did some research and made some changes.

Airport management officials agreed that we need to sell off the "expensive" fuel so that we can take advantage of the lower costs before they start to climb again.

With that strategy in mind, a new price of \$4.39/gallon was announced on Nov. 20th, making Bethel Regional Airport very competitive in the region.

Regional fuel price analyses will be performed by the airport coordinator on a weekly basis and adjustments to our price will be made accordingly to maintain our pricing commitment. Prices are posted on www.100LL.com and www.airnav.com websites.
