

CHAPTER 60. SEWER AND WATER USE

§ 60-35. Grease interceptors.

A. Grease, oil, and sand interceptors shall be provided when, in the opinion of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent, Selectmen, they are necessary for the proper handling of liquid wastes containing floatable grease in excessive amounts or any flammable wastes, sand or other harmful ingredients, except that such interceptors shall not be required for private living quarters or dwelling units. All interceptors shall be of a type and capacity approved by the Selectmen and shall be located so as to be readily and easily accessible for cleaning and inspection.

B. In maintaining these interceptors the owner(s) shall be responsible for the proper removal and disposal by legal and environmentally safe methods of the captured material and shall maintain records of the date, name of hauler, quantity hauled, and means of disposal. Signed copies of these records shall be submitted every ~~six months~~ one year to the Selectmen. Any removal and hauling of the collected materials ~~not performed by the owner's personnel~~ shall be performed by state-licensed waste disposal firms.
